WHY: The LGA was established to promote women's golf at MCC and to sponsor several special events throughout the season which include:

- P **Wednesday is Ladies Day at MCC** – come on out and play in the game of the day such as O-N-E-S, Ditch 'Em, 3-6-9, and lots of other fun games designed for the enjoyment of all golfers regardless of skill
- P **Member/Member Tournament** – no fee, included with LGA dues
- P **Handicap Tournament** – no fee, included with LGA dues
- P **Club Championships**, - flighted by handicap, no fee, included with LGA dues
- P **Ringer board**, flighted by handicap – initially record your score hole by hole on the appropriate board. Every time you play an official round there after check the board and change the score on any holes you bettered. Monthly, the lowest total score is awarded Pro Shop credit. No fee, included with LGA dues - a ringer board for **PUTTS ONLY** will also be available
- P Eagles (anytime made), Ladies Day Birdies and Pars should be recorded in the locker room. Those with the most will be honored at the Fall LGA meeting. No fee, included with LGA dues
- P **Member/Guest Invitational** is a 2 day event with an entry fee that includes awards and food
- P **Inter Clubs** are 18 hole rounds at area clubs (Bedford Valley, Battle Creek Country Club, Cedar Creek, Marywood, and Riverside). Foursomes of like handicap golfers play together. Awards include, low gross, low net, low putts in assorted flights by handicaps. A modest entry fee includes lunch. ***You must play in one of the Ladies Inter Club events to enter the Co-Ed Pinehurst to be held at Marywood this year***
- P **Central Districts** are similar to Inter Clubs and will be held at various clubs TBA. An entry fee is required. The LGA pays membership dues to the Women's Central District Golf Association
- P **Western Michigan Golf Association Districts** – the LGA joined this group for the first time in 2007 which enables LGA members to play in any of the WWMGA one day events at Gull Lake CC, Manistee Golf and CC, and Sunnybrook. The annual three day tournament (our own Linda Morrison is defending champion!) will be held at Pine River in Alma and the senior's tournament is scheduled for Lake Doster. An entry fee will be required
- P LGA members receive a booklet that explains everything the LGA does and includes the 2009 golf season calendar
- P The LGA stocks the locker room with assorted lady friendly products
- P The LGA has provided financial assistance for several club improvements (tee benches, table cloths, locker room improvements, window treatments, PA system, etc.) and the forward tee marker on #7
